The Nature of Baptism

The reception of the Sacrament of Baptism is the greatest day in the life of a child and a special family occasion, a time for rejoicing and thanking God. Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in God: Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Through Baptism your child will be freed from sin and reborn as a child of God. Moreover, the newly baptised become members of Christ's body, grafted into Christ and His Church and made sharers in the mission: to bring the gospel of salvation to all nations. The law of the Church requires every child to have at least one God parent. The number often differs. A God parent must be a practising Catholic — in good standing with the Church (able to receive Holy Communion) and have been confirmed. They must be at least 16 years of age. Believing and baptised Christians can act as Christian witness in place of one or more God parents, but in any case, there must always be at least one Catholic Godparent.
